

BUSINESS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

School Fees 2011/2012

“Resident” means that the pupil’s parents/legal guardians are resident in the Republic of Ireland. “Non-resident” means that the pupil’s parents/legal guardians are resident outside the Republic of Ireland.

In order to secure a pupil’s enrolment at the Lycée Français d’Irlande a deposit of €800 and an additional administration fee of €110 are payable. These are only payable once enrolment has been confirmed by the school. The deposit will be credited against the first term’s school fees. Both the deposit and the administration fee are non-refundable should the pupil not take up his/her place.

Payment Dates For School Fees

Annual payments must be made by 1st August 2011.

Payments per term must be made by:

- 1st August 2011;
- 1st December 2011; and
- 1st March 2012 respectively.

Enrolment at the Lycée Français d’Irlande is an annual contract. Pupils are enrolled, and places are secured, for the full school year. The full school fees for the year are due even if a pupil is unable to attend class for a part of it. It should be noted that non-payment of fees by the due date may result in the pupil(s) being excluded from school until such time as outstanding accounts are cleared in full. The Board of Management reserves the right both to levy a late payment penalty of 10% in respect of amounts outstanding on overdue invoices and to withhold all school documents from families in arrears.

Payment

All payments must be made in euros. The following are the only methods of payment accepted by the Lycée Français d’Irlande:

- cheques drawn on an Irish or French bank (for cheques drawn on a bank of any other country €20 must be added to cover charges);
- bank draft;
- cash; or

- bank transfer to either of the accounts detailed below.

Discounts on Fees

A discount on school fees is available for families with two or more children at the school. This discount is only available to families who pay the school fees by the due date shown on their invoices. The Board of Management reserves the right to withdraw the family discount if fees are not paid on time. The discount is currently:

- 10% for the second (younger) pupil; and
- 25% for the third (youngest) and subsequent pupils.

The Board of Management reviews the level and system of offering discounts annually and reserves the right to change or withdraw the discount in any future year.

Host Family Administration

A fee of €600 per year will be charged for access to the school's Host Families Co-ordination Service. If a host family is required, this fee is due on confirmation of enrolment at the same time as the deposit and administration fee.

Class Materials

Kindergarten classes (PS to GS): €40

Primary classes (CP to CM2): €70

In addition, charges will be made in respect of those primary pupils who attend Irish classes for materials provided in these classes.

Secondary classes (6^{ème} to Terminale): Pupils of the secondary school should provide their own class materials.

Lunch Supervision Charge

A fee of €222 per year (€74 per term) will be charged in respect of lunch supervision for the kindergarten and primary classes.
